The theme of this year's meeting is "**Holy City**," an appropriation of its bespired host city's nickname. The Organizing Committee invites proposals for papers that explore, from any disciplinary perspective, any aspect of the joining of the sacred and the urban in any medieval religious culture. "Holy City" may mean a place (e.g. Jerusalem, Rome, Mecca), a community, a concept. It may be real or imagined, theoretical or practical, coherent or confused, even inverted by vice and profanity. Interpret broadly and creatively. Proposals on other medieval topics, including teaching medieval culture, are also welcome.
